



## **Cell Values - Multiplication (everyone involved in friendship evangelism)**

### **Welcome (10 mins)**

Share about how you became a Christian (and if time the greatest and hardest things since).

### **Worship (20 mins)**

Read a few stories of what God is doing around the world (e.g. Brazil, China, Korea).

Ask different people to read out some scriptures: Psalm 2:8; Matthew 28:16-20 (from The Message - the last section of the Gospel, starting 'Meanwhile, the eleven disciples...')

Have a map of the world out in the middle (or a globe, or atlas - whatever you can manage to get your hands on!) - and give thanks to God together for what he is doing around the earth in different nations. Speak out abundant blessings over other nations!

### **Word (40 mins)**

Put on some quiet music and get the group to close their eyes. Let people know that for the next few minutes, as a group, you are going to let God stretch their imaginations. Encourage people to imagine that they are in their friend's home, or in the street (etc.) and that someone asks them how they can know Jesus. Help people to think through how they would feel if this happened. Encourage people to imagine the look on this person's face, and that they get to share with the person the good news about Jesus. Imagine that God leads them to pray for a sickness this person has and they see God heal that person.

Briefly share what people thought - did they find it difficult to imagine? To feel? Did this exercise inspire them?

In groups of 3-4, think through these questions:

- What stories did Jesus tell about Father's attitude to the lost? (See Luke 15 if you get stuck!) You may want to read these together quickly, pointing out things in the stories that have impacted you.
- What example does Jesus show us about people? What do you find most difficult to copy?
- Do you feel the same as Jesus about your friends who do not



- know him?
- Pray for each other in your groups of 3 to have more of God's heart for the lost.

### **Witness (20 mins)**

Take a short time to agree together what your aim is as a cell - when do you want to multiply by? Set some other goals together (socials, opportunities to pray with people etc.) (Remind people that Church is the only 'society' that exists for the sake of its non-members!) You may want to have a map of the local area out in the middle of the room. Declare together over the map what you want to see God do in your area - be specific! Alpha groups and people getting saved? (How many and by when?) Physical miracles? Dreams? Conviction of sin? Holiness? Strongholds broken? etc. Release the power of the Holy Spirit out from inside yourselves in worship, praise, declaration, tongues etc.

### **Notes**

You may want to plan a social (one a month?) which you can bring your friends along to.

An extra idea is to agree together to fast on a particular day of the week (either as one off or more regularly) and use this time to pray for God's salvation.

*"For Zion's sake I will not keep silent, for Jerusalem's sake I will not remain quiet, till her righteousness shines out like the dawn, her salvation like a blazing torch." (Isaiah 62:1)*
